DefExpo 2020, the 11th edition of the biennial mega defence exhibition, is scheduled to be held from 5th-8th February 2020 in Lucknow. The previous edition witnessed 160 international participants, 284 foreign/official delegates and 700 exhibitors, that resulted in more than 50 bilateral G2G meetings and the signing of 40 MoUs. DIGITAL TRANSFORMATION

With a focus on 'Digital Transformation', the upcoming edition is poised to witness large scale participation of a diverse global audience. Policymakers in India have also recognised the growing importance of the digital era, and various stakeholders have come together to create policies aimed at incentivising such technological developments that will be the catalysts for digital transformation of the defence manufacturing ecosystem.

UP DEFENCE INDUSTRIAL CORRIDOR

Announced by the Hon'ble PM Narendra Modi at the UP Investors Summit in February 2018, the corridor will leverage the existing manufacturing ecosystem in the state to create a robust and dedicated defence manufacturing space.

Major nodes: Aligarh, Agra, Jhansi, Chitrakoot, Kanpur and Lucknow.

Existing ecosystem in the state:

- 9 major ordnance factories
- 3 major manufacturing units of HAL and one major BEL unit
- Major existing R&D institutes in the state include those of DRDO, ASERDC-HAL, etc.

Existing enabling infrastructure:

- Located on the Golden Quadrilateral with an excellent road network
 Agra-Lucknow Expressway
- Major international and national airports connecting the state to the rest of the country
- Strong logistics infrastructure in Kanpur, Dadri, Boraki and Varanasi
